
Figure A: Opening Bids in No Trump - 1 NT or 2 NT or 3 NT



1) No 5-card major

- When holding a 5+card major, open that 5+card major instead of NT.
- This practice narrows and clarifies the specifics of the NT opening hand, and makes it easier to identify an 8+card fit in a major suit.
- It is OK to have a 5+card minor.

3 Criteria for Opening in NT

2) Must be Balanced

- No voids, No singletons, and 1 or 0 doubleton
- Distributions of balanced hands are described by the general notation:

4-3-3-3

4-4-3-2

5-3-3-2 (major suit cannot be 5-cards)

3) Specific HCP Ranges


Each No Trump open bid must be in one of three specific honor card point ranges

• 15 to 17 HCPs – Open 1 NT

• 20 to 21 HCPs – Open 2 NT

• 25 to 27 HCPs – Open 3 NT

Path 1 – Transfer Convention

Responder has 5-card Major

0 to 17 pts

- bid 2 ♦ or 4 ♦ (request xfr to hearts)
- bid 2 or 4 (request xfr to spades)

Responder has 6+card Major

0 to 13 pts

- bid 2 ♦ or 4 ♦ (request xfr to hearts)
- bid 2 ♥ or 4 ♥ (request xfr to spades)

14 to 17 pts

- bid **4**♦ (Xfr) or **3**♥ (natural)
- bid 4 ♥ (Xfr) or 3 ♠ (natural)

Path 2 – Stayman Convention

Responder has one or both a 4-card Majors

- 0 to 7 pts: bid **PASS**
- 8-17 pts: bid **2**

Stayman – looking for opener's 4-card major

Path 3 - NO 4-card Major

All hands: 0 to 7 pts: bid **PASS**

Balanced:

- 8 to 9 pts: bid 2 NT
- 10 to 17 pts: bid 3 NT


6+clubs:

- 8 to 9 pts: bid 2 NT
- 10 to 13 pts: bid 3 NT or 3 4
- 14 to 17 pts: bid 3 NT or 5 \$

6+diamonds:

- 8 to 9 pts: bid 2 NT
- 10 to 13 pts: bid 3 NT or 3 ◆
- 14 to 17 pts: bid 3 NT or 5 ◆

Path 1 – Transfer Convention

Responder has 5-card Heart Suit

- 0 to 13 pts: 2 ♦ (request Transfer to Hearts)
- 14 to 17 pts: 4♦ (request Texas Transfer to Hearts)

Responder has 6+card Heart Suit

- 0 to 9 pts: 2 ♦ (request Transfer to Hearts)
- 10 to 13 pts: 4♦ (request Texas Transfer to Hearts)
- 14-17 pts: 3 ♥ (natural bid)

Responder has 5-card Spade Suit

- 0 to 13 pts: 2 ♥ (request Transfer to Spades)
- 14 to 17 pts: 4 ♥ (request Texas Transfer to Spades)

Responder has 6+card Spade Suit

- 0 to 9 pts: 2 ♥ (request Transfer to Spades)
- 10 to 13 pts: 4 ♥ (request Texas Transfer to Spades)
- 14 to 17 pts: 3 ♠ (natural bid)

Figure C1: Path 1 – Transfers Responder has 5-Hearts




Figure C2: Path 1 – Transfers Responder has 5-Spades




Figure C3: Path 1 – Transfers Responder has 6+Hearts




Figure C4: Path 1 – Transfers Responder has 6+Spades





Figure D: Path 2 – Stayman 2 & Responder has a 4-card Major






Figure D1: Path 2 – Stayman 2♣ (Responder has 4-card Major)
Opener does NOT have a 4-card Major 2♦




Figure D2: Path 2 – Stayman 2 (Responder has 4-card Major)

Opener has 4-card Heart Suit (and maybe 4-card Spade Suit)




Figure D3: Path 2 – Stayman 2 ★ (Responder has 4-card Major)

Opener has 4-card Spade Suit 2 ★ (and NO 4-card Heart Suit)





Figure E: Path 3 – Responder does NOT have a 4+card Major






Figure E1: Path 3 – Responder does NOT have a 4+card Major Responder is Balanced





Figure E2: Path 3 – Responder does NOT have a 4+card Major Responder has 6+Clubs



Responder has 6+Diamonds




Figure F: Simple Transfers (for Beginners) Responder has a 5+card Major




Figure G: Simple Transfers Responder has 5+Hearts




Figure H: Simple Transfers Responder has 5+Spades
